Oakwood is a detached residence with 5 double bedrooms, 1 of which is on-suite, with shared communal areas consisting of a lounge, dining room and kitchen, where people can engage with each other, staff and visitors.

The staff team is led by a registered manager and a senior support worker who aid the people and their families in a holistic way ensuring that each person is enabled to take control of their own lives.

Based around a person centred programme (PCP), the team provide each person with opportunities to explore and develop their skills and interests to enhance their independence and to have a community presence.
